## **Continuous Improvement - The Mindset Entrepreneurs Need:**

An entrepreneur's success depends on getting the most out of their time, energy, and money. In this workshop we'll look at tools to grow a new or existing business and maintain a Continuous Improvement mindset.



## Pursuing Your Passions - How to Make Money from A Hobby:

Unlock the potential of your passions and turn your hobbies into a source of income! In this engaging and informative workshop, we will explore the exciting journey of transforming your favorite pastime into a profitable venture. Whether you love crafting, writing, photography, woodwork, or any other pursuit, this workshop is tailored to help you discover the pathways to financial success while doing what you love. Don't just dream it – monetize it!



### Rapid Prototyping - Unnecessary Inventions:

Teams of students will be given a prompt for an "unnecessary invention" that they must use 3D printing pens to rapidly prototype a product that would address the problem. Students will learn that rapid prototyping is often the first step for entrepreneurs eager to bring their innovative ideas to life. This hands-on experience teaches students the vital role of prototyping in product development, demonstrating how rapid prototyping can effectively test a product's functionality before it is mass-produced.



#### **Closing Session - Pitch Perfect:**

This dynamic closing activity helps students dive into the art of pitching and presentation skills! Participants will have the unique opportunity to craft and present their own fun and innovative ideas, honing their ability to communicate effectively in a pitch setting. From refining elevator pitches to mastering stage presence, this session promises a lively environment where students not only learn but actively apply key skills.
